

# VO-TCS Report on Quality and Assurance

For Ground based webcams

## Quality assurance:

Images from three webcams that took pictures during the Holuhraun eruption are available. Images are available for 2014-08-29 - 2015-02-28. Cameras are named after the geographical feature where they were mounted. Dyngjujökull, located at 64.5041, -17.2357, Kiðagilsdrög, located at 65.0192, -17.9424, and Vaðalda located at 64.9751, -16.4905. Kiðagilsdrög and Vaðalda were pointed towards the 2014-2015 eruption site while Dyngjujökull was pointed along the propagating dyke in case of a vent opening along there, and as such, it did not record the eruption. Images from Dyngjujökull and Kiðagilsdrög are taken every 10 minutes and from Vaðalda every minute.

## Quality check:

Images are only taken and sent when there is enough power at the stations. You do not see anything in the images when it is foggy, when it is dark and when the lens of the camera housing is iced up.
